

Northern Manitoba & Nunavut's Premiere 5 Star Fly-in Fishing and Hunting Destination

The Lodge at Little Duck is nestled in the heart of Northern Manitoba's Sub Arctic Wilderness, roughly 700 miles north of Winnipeg MB. This is truly a fascinating land that has changed very little over time.

Over 250 miles separates us from the closest road or intrusion making the wilderness experience at The Lodge at Little Duck all that more adventurous. We also use this main lodge location in the fall as the transfer point for all of our Nunavut Caribou hunters.

No other lodge this far north welcomes its guests to the convenience and comforts of a full service Northern 5 Star Lodge complete with chef prepared meals, individual cabin accommodation with private ensuite, daily cabin service, thermostatically controlled heat, 24 hour a day power and a fully modern, .cedar appointed Main Lodge.

All our camps are connected with high speed Internet (if you choose to use) and Wi-Fi calling is also available using your smart phone.

Our chartered single and twin turbo prop aircraft brings you safely to our 3500' private airstrip that is equipped with a "state of the art" GPS Approach, a system similar to what is used at most major airports This enables our aircraft to take off and land safely even in periods of inclement weather. The Lodge at Little Duck was the first and is still one of the few lodges in Manitoba that has embraced this flight safety technology.

This is the land of the midnight summer sun, and in the fall our guests are able to experience the colorful and ever changing displays of the northern lights. Nothing compares to the allure of the Aurora Borealis; natural, mysterious and unforgettable! You'll be thankful to have your camera along.

This magnificent part of Northern Manitoba is also located within the home range of the Qamanirjuaq Caribou Herd that is still conservatively estimated at well over 325,000 animals.

In addition, we offer Caribou hunts north of the 60th parallel in the Territory of Nunavut in partnership with Henik Lake Adventures. We offer Trophy Caribou Hunts at our Edehon Lake and Baralzon Lake Caribou Camps. We still remain the only outfitter in this vast area of Nunavut to offer these very high percentage and very successful Trophy caribou hunts.

We also offer spring and fall muskox hunts from the vicinity of the community of Baker

Lake which is roughly 1100 miles north of Winnipeg Manitoba, our departure point for these exciting hunts. We access the spring muskox herds location using snowmachine, returning to the warmth and comfort of your private room for an end of day hot shower at the Nunamiut Lodge.

During the fall hunts a caribou can be added to the Muskox package, making this a very sought after combo hunt. We have maintained a 100% success rate for over 12 years on muskox with over 85% of animals making B&C.

In 2017, one of our guests harvested a monster muskox bull of a lifetime that is currently the #1 SCI World Record. Quite an honor!!

With your safety in mind, our experienced, dedicated and highly motivated team will provide you with the friendly and personalized experience you would expect from an outfitter.

FISHING

Experience the Incredible Trophy Fishing at The Lodge at Little Duck

Last Season Our Guests Averaged Seven Manitoba Master Angler Fish Per Person

Fish for Trophy Northern Pike, Lake Trout and Arctic Grayling at our Northern 5 Star Wilderness Fishing Lodge. The waters of Little Duck and Neganilini Lakes along with the Wolverine River system are virtually untouched and provide unlimited opportunities to catch all three species of trophy fish. Since we are the only lodge on the lake, our guests have over 300,000 acres of private waters to fish and explore without the possibility of seeing any other boats other than ours.

Hundreds of miles of shoreline with numerous shallow weedy bays, deep summer holes, mid lake reefs, streams and rapids provide ideal structure on any given day for trophy sized Northern Pike, Lake Trout and Arctic Grayling. A Manitoba record 22" Grayling was caught on a fly within sight of The Lodge and guests have battled monster Northern Pike up to 53". Lake Trout in the 40" – 48"range are not uncommon. With this quality fishery, theres no need for "daily fly-outs" at The Lodge at Little Duck!!

Because of our northerly location, the ice on our lakes is not typically out until the last week of June. This time of year provides incredible sight fishing opportunities for Northern Pike, and it's very common to catch these monsters in 1 – 3 feet of crystal clear water. These fish are post spawn, and are basking in the warmer water that these back bays provide. Lake Trout are also still very shallow (4-12 ft.) and Arctic Grayling are congregated in the moving water of the rivers and streams preparing for the spawning period in the weeks to come. Fall Fishing - We offer 5 & 10 day all inclusive packages with departures directly from Winnipeg or Thompson MB. Unlike other lodges, we get you into camp the night before your package starts, so you're fishing on the first day of your package, not traveling.

All our boats are custom Alumarine Pro Guide models complete with 40 & 50 hp Yamaha 4 stroke motors. Each boat is equipped with depth find-er/GPS units, radio communication between boats and main lodge, boat safety equipment, life jackets and topped off with experienced, helpful and friendly guides. Complimentary Shimano rods and reels and are also available for those that choose not to bring their own equipment.

Over the past 4 decades, The Lodge at Little Duck has been extremely consistent in their "catch and release" policy. Only a few smaller fish will be allowed to be harvested daily for either lunch or dinner purposes. The winner of this policy has always been our guests who reap the benefits with the high number of Trophy Fish that are caught on a daily basis.

Whether your passion is fly fishing with large streamers for pike and lake trout or using tiny nymphs for grayling, or using spin cast gear with spoons or spinners, the waters surrounding The Lodge at Little Duck definitely has an angling adventure for everyone. FALL FISHING AT ITS BEST LATE AUGUST -SEPTEMBER

Lake Trout, Northern Pike and Arctic Grayling

Ever wondered what it's like to fish for monster lake trout and actually catch them in 3-5 ft. of water? The answer is quite simple. It's absolutely amazing! The last week of August and the first couple weeks of September will see these huge female lake trout move to shallow rocky reefs and points in anticipation of their annual spawn.

These magnificent fish are displaying their full fall spawning colors that can only be seen at this special time of year. And if you think they are sluggish during this period, you are sadly mistaken. They will absolutely crush any bait that comes by their view.



Whether you are casting a 5-7" streamer or trolling an assortment of large spoons on mid lake reefs or rock piles, the results are the same....huge lake trout. We have yet to find a spoon that is too big for these fish, and a 3-1/4 oz. Husky Devle, 5 of diamonds is as good a spoon as any.

We use single barbless hooks for easy releases, and practice CPR (catch, photograph, and release) to make sure this incredible fishery remains strong and sustainable for not only us, but for future generations as well. The average size of the trout varies, but you can be rest assured there is an abundance of trout in the 35-40" class and many that are in excess of 45". During a period of 1+ day, a lucky group of hunters that were all tagged out on their caribou hunt had over 40 Manitoba Master Angler Lake Trout (the minimum Master Angler lake trout is 35").

On top of the fantastic fall lake trout fishing, The Lodge at Little Duck still has some of the best pike fishing to be found anywhere in the north. These toothy predators are constantly stalking these shallow waters looking for their next meal and to beef up as much as possible in anticipation of the hard water season, which as you can imagine, lasts quite a while in the north. Arctic Grayling are also available in big numbers this time of year, and can be fished in the tranquil and moving waters of the Wolverine River, which just happens to be located right behind The Lodge at Little Duck.

The grayling are also quite active this time of year and can be caught using different techniques with spin cast or a fly. It is not unusual to have a 16 inch grayling on the end of your line only to have a huge lake trout come up and completely swallow the grayling. After that, and with 6 lb test line, the fight is on.

Our Fall fishing starts the last week of August and goes through the month of September. Come and experience firsthand the beautiful fall colors of our northern landscape during the day, while experiencing the magical colors of the "northern lights" at night.

We're sure you will enjoy the hospitality of Manitoba's premiere 5 Star fly-in fishing and hunting lodge and experience first hand some of the best fall fishing to be found anywhere in North America.

Whether your game is fly-fishing, trolling, jigging or casting, there are plenty of ways to take advantage of the incredible fall fishery we have at The Lodge at Little Duck.

HUNTING

Central Barren Ground Caribou

Come and join us for a incredible Caribou hunting adventure in the pristine sub-arctic wilderness areas of Northern Manitoba and South-Central Nunavut. Here you'll experience one of the last few remaining opportunities in North America to hunt for Trophy Central Barren Ground Caribou.

We are still the only outfitter that offers Caribou hunts in both Manitoba and further north above the 60th parallel in the Territory of Nunavut. We are fully licensed outfitters in both jurisdictions and have the knowledge and experience to help you plan a trophy caribou hunting trip of a lifetime. This is what we do.


We offer our guests the option of choosing between the amenities of our Northern 5 Star hunting lodge in Manitoba, or the extremely comfortable and hunter friendly remote caribou camps in the Territory of Nunavut. We have over 500 square miles of prime Caribou hunting habitat at our disposal.

You can choose to hunt with rifle, bow or black powder. The landscape is not hard to navigate and combined with the use of boats allows us to tailor a hunt to anyones preference or physical ability. Small stands of spruce, dwarf birch along with outcroppings of rock and natural ridges adds for a great "spot and stock" hunt for that monster Caribou of a lifetime. We harvest exceptional B&C and P&Y trophy bulls each and every year. Along with Caribou, some hunters are also able to harvest either a wolf or Wolverine during their hunt.

One person that hunted with us in Manitoba 2023 will legitimately challenge and could possibly set new all-time records for both gun and bow kills. This is pretty impressive as the previous Manitoba Trophy records have been on the books for decades. Potentially doing both in one season with two different types of weapons is an accomplishment of a lifetime and a feat someone only dreams about.

Regardless of where you choose, personal service is still the name of the game and you'll find this at whatever camp you decide to hunt from. All our camp staff and our guides will go above and beyond to ensure your trip is safe and successful.

Our hunting season starts at the end of August and goes through to the 4th week of September. Our caribou hunts are "all-inclusive" and are fully guided 2 X 1 by licensed Manitoba or Nunavut guides who are true outdoor professionals that have many years of guiding/ hunting experience. MUSKOX

Baker Lake Nunavut

We offer several different hunting experiences for Muskox during both our spring and fall hunts that compliments each season and provides great adventure for the hunter.

The animals of this area are the Barren Ground sub species of Musk Ox. They are typically larger than their island cousins by about 10-15% in body and horn size. On average, well over 85% of the animals taken by our hunters will meet or exceed the Boone & Crockett minimum scoring. We are proud of the fact that one of our hunters has held the #1 SCI World record Muskox for the past 7 years.

Our licensed hunting guides are also community hunters, meaning the skill and knowledge they have of the the land and animals is second to none. They will do what it takes to ensure you have a safe and successful hunting adventure. Even with our close hunting proximity to the community, these animals are not generally targeted by local hunters which has led to 100% success since 2012. Also, by hunting this area we are able to offer comfortable lodge type accommodations on both our spring and fall hunts with end of day hot showers and delicious meals.

Our spring hunts will have hunters and guides using snow machines to access the various late winter areas used by the Muskox herds. During this time of year, the Muskox "coat" is at it's most "pristine condition" of the year. Full, straight and thick. It has once again protected the animals from the harsh Arctic winter. Experiencing the open tundra, a place you have probably never seem and driving ones own snowmachine in search of your trophy muskox herds is as exhilarating an experience as any.

On our fall hunts our hunters and guides will be using their own ATV's to access various late summer/early fall areas frequented by Muskox.

This time of year the "rut" is on and most groups of Muskox you encounter will have a dominant bull that will be larger in scale than other members of the herd. Once the desired animal is located and is determined stalkworthy, the hunter and guide will move in. With bulls competing for breeding rights, and the hunter having favorable foliage and terrain, this lends to a very successful opportunity for both gun and bow hunters alike.

Since there are Central Barren Ground Caribou in the same areas as the Musk Ox, this is a great way to add on a second big-game species to your fall Musk Ox hunting adventure.

We can also organize camp based hunts for those adventure minded hunters that want a closer hunting experience to the land.

Getting To Winnipeg

Most major airlines connect into Winnipeg's James Armstrong Richardson International Airport. Direct flights to Winnipeg are available daily from Chicago, Minneapolis and Denver including all other major Canadian cities. Overnighting in Winnipeg is required prior to the start of your Muskox hunt





Getting To Thompson

Once in Winnipeg, we suggest Calm Air which normally has daily flights to and from Thompson daily. Overnighting in Thompson is required prior to the start of your fall fishing or caribou hunting package.
